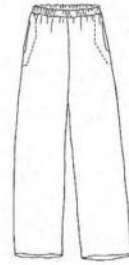

Uniform Policy



Kindergarten – 8th Grade

Uniform Policy

Options

Students may choose from a variety of options in order to be appropriately dressed for school:

Shirts – Navy, Red or White- must match swatches supplied by school

Students may wear plain collar, button up, polo, turtleneck, or mock turtlenecks. All shirts acceptable in long and short sleeve. Shirts with shirttails must be tucked in; straight hem shirts may be left untucked. Belts are preferred but not required.

Pants, shorts, skirts and shorts – Khaki only

Students may wear long pants, twill khakis, Capri's, skorts, skirts, jumpers or shorts as long as they are no more than 2 inches above knees or longer and are not torn or in any way in disrepair. Shorts may be worn in September and May only and not on Mass days.

Plaid jumpers, skirts or skorts - These plaid jumpers must match Donald's plaid-#9455 or #55. All skirts, skorts or shorts must be no more than 2 inches above the knee or longer.

Sweaters – True Red or Navy

Students may wear solid plain sweaters, zip-up, vest or pullover, with or without embroidered logo. Sweaters must be worn with a white shirt as described above. 5-8th grade students may wear navy or red St. Francis hoodies. Hoodies may be worn in red or navy if plain and no lettering. Student K-4 may not have "hoodies".

Sweatshirts– True Red or Navy

Students may wear solid plain sweatshirts, zip-up, cardigan, button down or pullover with or without embroidered logo. Sweatshirts must be worn with a shirt under it as described above.

Tights- must be white, navy or red.

Socks - Colored socks of your choice may be worn. No-show socks will not be allowed

Shoes must have a strap, no flip-flops. Socks must be worn. Gym shoes separate from regularly worn shoes for Physical Education must be worn.

Middle School Gym Attire

Students may wear navy blue shorts or sweatpants and plain navy or white T-shirt.

Criteria

The following criteria apply to all clothing choices:

- Midriff must not show at any time.
- Clothing may not be torn or in any way in disrepair.
- No portion of a student's undergarments may be visible.
- Hooded sweaters and sweatshirts are not allowed in school, except for Middle School plain or St. Francis hoodies.
- Appropriate Tennis shoes must be worn for physical education.
- Jewelry worn must be simple and modest, no hoop earrings.
- No makeup for K-5th grade students. No extreme make-up, body piercing, hair colors or styles are permitted. Fad clothing or accessories are not part of the uniform.
- School Attire will be worn for Mass days. Shorts may not be worn on Mass days.
- Shorts worn in September and May only.
- Middle School will change for gym.

» FAQs

How will this policy be enforced?

Teachers will complete a uniform violation form for students inappropriately dressed. Students may be asked to change into clothing available at the school.

What if students aren't "in policy"?

The first violation will result in a note to the parents and a discussion with the student. Parents will be contacted after the second violation and will be asked to bring appropriate clothing to school for their child.
